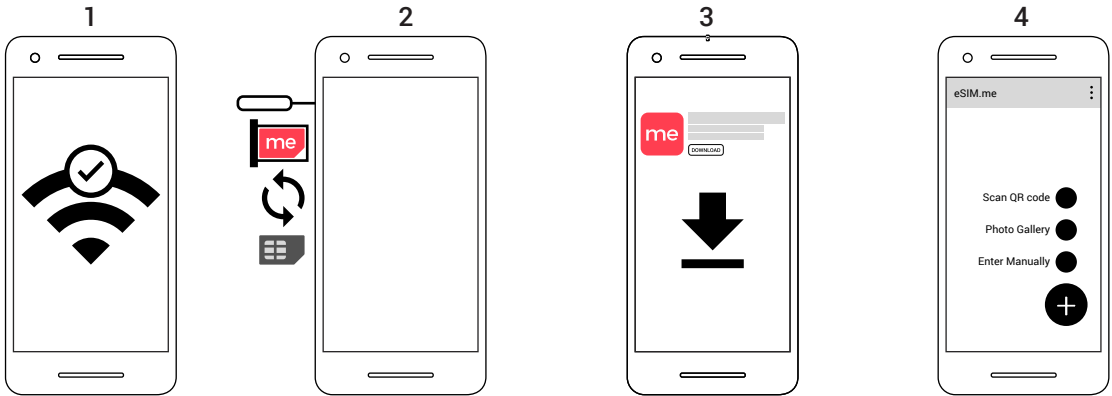


Install the eSIM.me Card and download the eSIM.me APP

Make sure you have a WiFi connection to the internet.

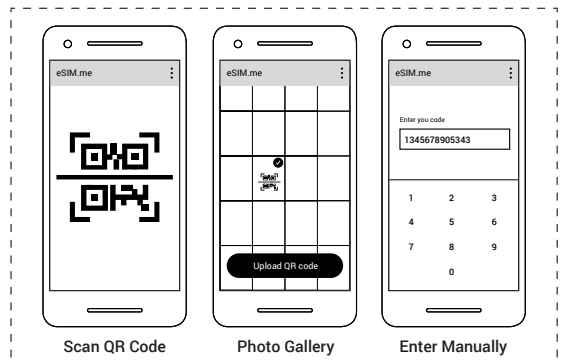
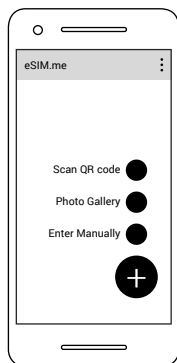

Insert the eSIM.me Card into the SIM card slot.

Download the eSIM.me APP from the Google Playstore.

4
Open the eSIM.me APP and tap on the "+" icon.

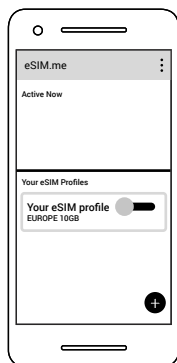
How to download and enable eSIM profiles with the eSIM.me APP

To download an eSIM profile:

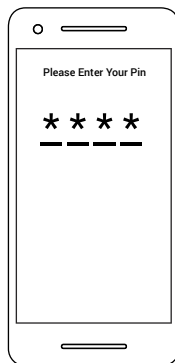


You can add an eSIM by scanning a **QR-code***, loading a QR-Code from your **photo gallery** or by entering the code **manually**.

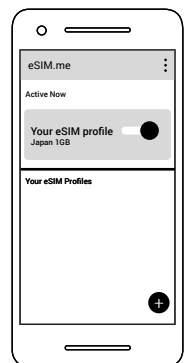
To enable the downloaded eSIM profile:



Slide the switch to the right to enable the eSIM profile.



If requested enter the PIN**.



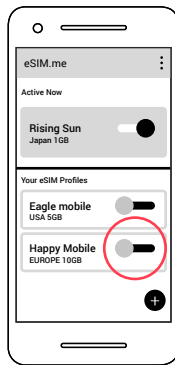
Now your eSIM profile is enabled.

* QR-Codes are provided by the cellular connectivity provider and mobile network operator of your choice.

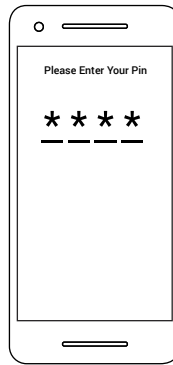

How to manage eSIM profiles

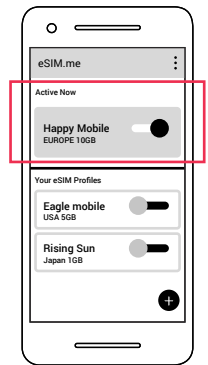
To swap between eSIM profiles:



To enable an eSIM profile, slide the switch to the right.

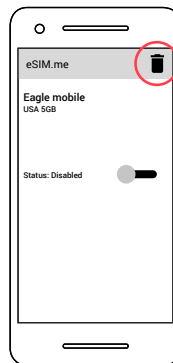
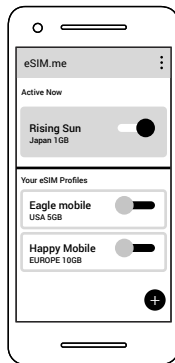


If requested enter the PIN**.



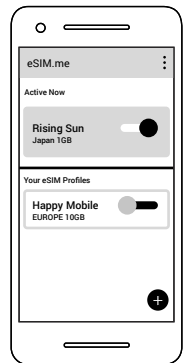
The desired eSIM profile is now enabled.

To delete unused eSIM profiles:



Unused eSIM profiles can be deleted by tapping the trash bin icon on the top-right corner.

eSIM profiles will need to be disabled first, before they can be deleted. Otherwise the trash bin icon will not be available.
